Local and state officials were on hand Thursday morning for the ribbon cutting for Bloomfield Farms on Spencer Mattingly Lane, Bardstown. The business is a new venture for Blend Pak of Bloomfield. The business will offer a full-line of gluten-free retail and bulk products. Among the speakers was U.S. Rep. Brett Guthrie, who said he was glad to attend the opening of Bloomfield Farms because his daughter has celiac disease and cannot eat gluten. Owners Dan and Sue Sutherland said they decided to start Bloomfield Farms because they saw a need for gluten-free products for those who are intolerant or simply prefer a gluten-free diet. The new venture is in a separate facility than Blend Pak to prevent cross-contamination.
