

Seminar to cover Small Business Investment Credit Program

Small business owners and managers, or anyone interested in boosting small businesses, are invited to a free seminar. The Nelson County Economic Development Agency and Bardstown-Nelson County Chamber of Commerce will join the Kentucky Economic Development Cabinet's Small Business Division 10-11:30 a.m. Jan. 12 at My Old Kentucky Home State Park's Great Hall.

The seminar will cover the Kentucky Small Business Investment Credit Program. According to NCEDA, the tax-credit program encourages job creation and capital investment by Kentucky small businesses (50 or fewer employees) that invest at least \$5,000 in qualifying equipment or technology.

NCEDA President Kim Huston said she knows little else about the program as it is just being launched. She and the seminar's attendees will learn together, she said.

The program likely stems from requests from organizations such as NCEDA for the state to remember small businesses instead of only focusing on industry, Huston said.
